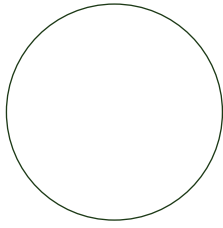



# Please make Chestertown a green town!

*Some tips to help you  
save money and make  
green choices:*

- ✓ Put recycling items in the green bins and place them by the curb on scheduled collection days. The Kent County recycling program picks up aluminum, metal cans, plastic bottles and packaging, glass bottles, mixed paper, newsprint, cardboard and paperboard. - ✓ Replace old light bulbs with compact fluorescent ones.
- ✓ Turn off lights, and unplug tv's and computers when not in use; install timers or motion sensors for porch and driveway lights.

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- ✓ Make fewer trips in your car; slow down; get a tune-up; and have the tire pressure checked.
  - ✓ Walk more!
  - ✓ Plant more trees and bushes around your property.
  - ✓ Use cold water for washing clothes.
  - ✓ Lower the thermostat by three degrees in winter, and raise it in summer.
  - ✓ Adjust the hot-water heater to no more than 120 degrees.
  - ✓ Take shorter showers; install low-flow shower heads.
  - ✓ Take a cloth or mesh bag when you shop; avoid using the plastic bags that stores provide.
  - ✓ Share these ideas with your friends and neighbors.
